To mark our 2026 Centennial year our parish commits to a \$8 million capital campaign to repair, renovate and enhance both our seventy-year-old church and our ninety-six year old school.

The renovation and enhancement of our beautiful buildings provides a sustainable foundation for the still more important work of winning hearts and souls for God. We invite you to prayerfully consider how you are able to contribute to this crucial effort for your parish and join with us in praying for the success of our campaign!

Campaign Case >>

Our church and school are in need of significant repairs that require immediate attention. Focusing on these projects now will allow our faithful to focus on our most important mission - Evangelization.

We ask Jesus Christ to equip our parish for the exciting work of bringing others to our Savior because in Him alone are souls saved and human life made whole. To prepare our buildings for the work at hand we embark on a capital campaign to raise \$8 million for repairs and upgrades to our parish and school.

As we look to the future these repairs will be vital for preserving our church and school!

Project Scope

Church Projects

Beautification of the church to include: decorative painting of the ceiling, sanctuary and nave walls, new windows, energy-efficient lighting system, replacement of the carpet with a tiled floor. Also included:

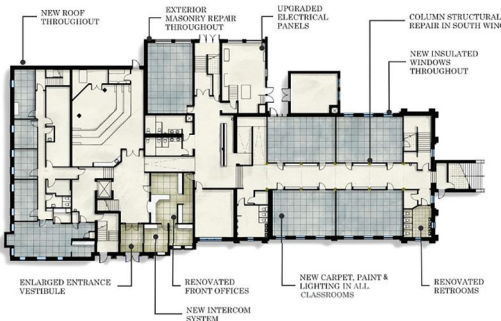
- Roof repair - extensive repair of the original tile roof
- Replace pews
- Upgrade audio
- Update bathrooms
- Remodel Vestibule

>> **ESTIMATED Cost: \$4,000,000**

School Projects

- Energy efficient window replacement providing air quality and comfort upgrades
- Maximize school building security
- Update classrooms
- Upgrade areas for teachers and staff
- Remodel bathrooms
- Repair foundation - address leaks in the foundations
- Structural column repairs

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How will we pay for these repairs and when will the work begin?

A. Funds for the repair and enhancement of our church and school buildings will be raised via our Centennial Capital Campaign. Father Hilton has made the commitment to have on hand in the form of cash or pledges all required funds prior to the start of construction so as to avoid placing the parish into debt.

The initial phase of school entrance and office upgrades will be completed this summer. The renovation of the church and the remainder of the school will begin in the Spring of 2025 and be completed in the Fall of 2025.

Q. What will happen if we go over our goal?

A. All gifts collected after we exceed our goal will be put towards additional renovation projects such as the repair of the church parking lot.

Q. Why should I make a pledge?

A. Most people take advantage of time-payments for major purchases. A pledge to the parish Capital Campaign is a "time-payment plan" that makes it possible for you to meet your parish and school obligations without undue hardship. Pledges enable you to consider a more significant contribution to the campaign rather than a one-time gift.

Q. Is my pledge over and above my Sunday Offering?

A. Yes. We will be successful with a little extra sacrifice. We cannot reach our goal if we reduce our weekly giving in order to make a pledge to the campaign. The parish and school will continue to have normal operating expenses during the pledge period.

Q. Who will be asked to support the Campaign?

A. Every parish and school family will be invited to be a part of this effort. It is our hope that every family will make a sacrificial gift for this major effort according to his or her financial ability. We hope everyone will play a conscientious role in renewing the future of the parish and school.

Q. What happens if I cannot fulfill my pledge?

A. Pledges are made in good faith and accepted as such. If hardship or illness prevents you from fulfilling your pledge, let the office know, and other arrangements will be made.

Fulfilling Your Pledge



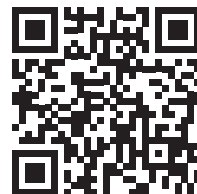
